SCC utilizes an Early Alert System to help with retention of veterans and active duty personnel. An advisor personally contacts each student who shows up in this system. SCC is in the process of implementing a method of tracking goal completion of veterans and active duty personnel.

SCC provides the following accommodations (as appropriate) for students called to active duty during the semester:

If called to active duty during the semester, the semester does not count as a withdrawal.

SCC accepts military credit.

SCC uses the *ACE Guide to the Evaluation of Educational Experiences in the Armed Services* in making the determination for accepting credit.

SCC accepts Defense Activity for Non-Traditional Education Support (DANTES) credits.
