Shawnee Community College announces additional information regarding COVID-19 Response.

ULLIN, IL (March 13, 2020) – Shawnee Community College provided additional information today regarding plans for education delivery during the ongoing concerns over the COVID-19 virus. Interim-President Dr. Kathleen Curphy announced that in addition to the Spring Break extension for students, which runs through March 23rd, the faculty are utilizing the extension to move face-to-face courses to online or synchronous meeting delivery options. The alternative delivery options will begin on March 23rd. Face-to-face classes that did not convert to an alternative delivery option will resume on that day.

In addition to the class conversions, many large-group functions have been and will be cancelled. Cancellations include the Annual Career Fair originally scheduled for next week and the upcoming High School Business Skills Competition. Currently, no alternate dates have been set for cancelled events. Due to the ever-changing situations related to the COVID-19 virus, additional updates or changes will be released as information becomes available.
