## Zoom Appointments Only

### **Prior to Your Zoom Appointment**

- Create an FSA ID at <u>www.studentaid.gov/fsaid</u> for both student (and parent, if dependent); if dependent, must use separate e-mail addresses.
- The FSA ID takes one to three days to verify with the Social Security Administration, so please make sure you apply for it well before your FAFSA completion event.

#### **Have the Following Available**

- Social security numbers for student and parent
- Verified FSA ID username and password for student (and parent, if dependent)
- 2019 Income Taxes
- 2019 W-2's and/or 1099s
- 2019 Child Support Received
- 2019 Child Support Paid
- Any other income in 2019

A FAFSA must be on file to receive a scholarship, grant, or loan at any college or university
