Student Enrollment

- ❖ SCC serves ~2,700 individuals annually through credit and non-credit courses. *(ICCB 2021 A1)*
- ❖ 52% percent of the SCC student body is over the age of 25. *(ICCB 2020A1 *Data not available for 2021)*
- ❖ The average age of SCC's students is 34. *(ICCB 2020A1 *Data not available for 2021)*
- ❖ Approximately 33% of SCC's students are male and 67% are female. *(ICCB 2021A1)*
- ❖ More than 85% of students reside in the SCC district. *(ICCB 2020A1 *Data not available for 2021)*
- ❖ In the 2021 academic year, SCC students generated a total of ~27,000 credit hours. *(ICCB 2021SR/SU)*
- ❖ Last year 76% of SCC full-time, first-time degree/certificate seeking students received some form of grant or scholarship aid. *(IPEDS 2019-20 Student Financial Aid)*
- ❖ Approximately 19% of SCC full-time, first-time degree seeking students transfer to four-year colleges/universities. *(IPEDS 2019-20 Graduation Rate Data)*

Graduates

- ❖ The Associate of Arts degree has 129 graduates, and the Practical Nursing program has 78 graduates, making them SCC's largest programs. *(ICCB 2020A2 *Data not available for 2021)*
- ❖ 99 less than one-year certificates were awarded to SCC students last year. *(IPEDS 2019-20 Completions)*
- ❖ 200 less than two-year, greater than one-year certificates were awarded. *(IPEDS 2019-20 Completions)*
- ❖ 269 Associate's degrees were awarded. *(IPEDS 2019-20 Completions)*

Faculty and Staff

- ❖ The student to faculty ratio at SCC is roughly 17 to 1. *(IPEDS 2019-20 Fall Enrollment Survey Summary)*
- ❖ SCC employs 96 full time faculty/staff and 71 part-time faculty/staff. *(ICCB2020 C1 *Data not available for 2021)*
