a. Dr. Shelby is the SCC HLC Accreditation Liaison Officer. She is leading and will be working with the College's shared governance teams on drafting responses and evidence collection as it relates to the HLC assurance argument criterion subcomponents. The CTE programs will continue to be updated. There are examples of evidence for them to follow for the assurance of performance.



They will review CCAF data from previous years and write their CQI. Examples from what they learned, including the sharing of some sample artifacts, will be used in presentations to emphasize conversations about assessment, sharing findings, and general instructional improvements. Assessment is a time reserved for ALL programs/departments to plan for the upcoming year based on the previous year's findings. Dr. Teske led the SCC HLC team to create a list of documents related to assessment (Core Component 4b). Everything is ongoing. Information will continue to update in the shared drive. Once the information is there, they will proceed and catalog the evidence. SAAT will need to read and review the assurance argument when it is finished.

# WIDS Training Review
