## **Statement**

Students have the opportunity to earn college credits through the College Level Examination Program (CLEP). CLEP credit will not be awarded for any course the student is currently enrolled in, nor for any equivalent course in which the student has already received a grade. Additionally, CLEP credits will not count in the current semester's credit hours and will not affect a student's full-time or part-time status for financial aid purposes.

To schedule a CLEP exam, students may contact the Student Success Center or visit [collegeboard.org](http://collegeboard.org) for additional information. Official CLEP exam scores must be submitted to the Registrar's office. Shawnee Community College awards credits based on the recommendations of the American Council on Education. For students who achieve the required exam score, credit will be posted to their record with a grade of "CR".
