I. Call to Order

- Mande Trowbridge reminded the team that scholarships do not follow the FAFSA calendar. She suggests the seniors do the 24-25 FAFSA this fall when they complete the scholarship application. She also suggested whoever talks to the seniors familiarize themselves with the 10 basic requirements for scholarships. These are listed in the scholarship book.
- Carrie suggested financial aid staff visit the high schools once in the fall semester and once in the spring semester.

b. Participation in community events

Carrie Davis reported that we plan to participate in 3 community parades coming up in the next week. They are the Heritage Blues Fest parade in Cairo, the Cache River Days parade in Ullin, and the Labor Day parade in Metropolis.
